

**MINUTES OF THE
WEST BATON ROUGE PARISH ZONING COMMISSION
Tuesday, April 20, 2010**

A regular meeting of the West Baton Rouge Parish Zoning Commission was held on Tuesday, April 20, 2010 in the Parish Council Meeting Room, 880 N. Alexander Avenue, Port Allen, Louisiana. The meeting was called to order by Chairman John Tilton at 6:30 PM.

Upon motion of Sidney Blanchard, seconded by Kevin Leblanc, the minutes of the April 4, 2010, meeting was approved as written. The motion carried unanimously.

Correspondence from the Council Clerk, Sharon Zito was read.

Public hearing:

- 1) An ordinance to amend and reenact West Baton Rouge Compiled Ordinances, Part III (“Unified Development Code”), Chapter 101 (“General Provisions”), Section 101-1 (“Definitions”) to provide for the definition of “livestock keeping (residential setting)” in the spirit of the animal control and zoning laws of West Baton Rouge Parish.
- 2) An ordinance to amend and reenact West Baton Rouge Compiled Ordinances, Part III (“Unified Development Code”), Chapter 104 (“Zoning Ordinance”), Appendix A (“Zoning Districts”) to provide for special use permit requirements for the zoning classification of “livestock keeping (residential setting)” in the spirit of the animal control laws of West Baton Rouge Parish

There was a short discussion among the Commission Members with no comment from the audience.

Kevin LeBlanc made a motion, seconded by Bobby Blanchard to close the public hearing. The motion carried unanimously.

The vote was as follows:

The Motion carried with a 4 to 2 vote.

Other Business: Mrs. Cline informed the Commission Members that there is a handout in their meeting packet, for review, with the latest updates to the Ethics laws and handouts.
